to for my Services as Boatswain's mate on board the Privateer Schoo-
mer General San Martin, at that time commanded by Captain
Deta. Also one Share more, which was granted me, in consideration
of Services performed as Prize Master's mate on board a prize
ship called the Lemania. I also give devise and bequeath to my
friend Doctor Noratus S. Waring, Physician, of Charleston in the State
aforesaid, all my right and title and interest in and to one Prize

180. Ticket, which I purchased for twenty Dollars, from John W. [unclear],
but which was unfortunately lost on board the Ship Louisiana, off
the Port of Charleston. Upon the back of my Ticket was endorsed
sixty two dollars, which I had received from Higginbotham, our
agent in the Port of Buenos Ayres. Trusting therefore to the
honor and Integrity of Mr. Higginbotham, I confidently hope
that he will discharge the claims herein set forth; all ^{of which} are
just and legal amounting in the whole to more or less than
Four hundred Dollars. Lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint
my friend Doctor Amos J. Waring, Physician of Charleston
in the State aforesaid to be sole Executor of this my last will
and Testament, revoking and annulling all former Wills by
me heretofore made, ratifying and confirming this and none
other to be my last Will and Testament. In testimony whereof
