Item I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint Mr Henry F. Paber Mr Joseph W. Faber as Executors and Mrs Maria C. Faber as Executrix of this my Last will and testament. Lastly I do hereby revoke all and every will by me heretofore made. In Witness whereof I have hereunto Set my Hand and Seal at Charleston this Eighteenth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and twenty Six and in the fifty first year of American Independence.
