ing the salvation of the same through the alone merits of Jesus Christ my Blessed
Saviour and Redeemer and may I pray to be buried at the discretion of my Executors
hereafter named and as for what temporal estate I have pleased God to bestow upon
me in this world, I do give, devise and bequeath and dispose of the same as is herein
and hereby set down mentioned and expressed and will that all my just debts be fully
satisfied, contented and paid. I then I give devise and bequeath unto my loving wife
Susannah Butler all my real and personal estate, goods & chattels whatever
to her and her heirs forever. Lastly I nominate and appoint my well beloved
Friends James Singleton and Charles Butler and my loving wife Susannah
Butler to be Executors and Executrix to this my last Will and Testament In
Witness ^{whereof} I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 19th day May Anno Domini 1748th
and in the 21st year of His Majesty's Reign.
