 give to my Grandmother in consideration of her great Kind-
 nefs to me through Life my negro Slaves Juliet and Will with
 the future issue and increase of the said Juliet for and
 during her natural Life and from and immediately after her
 death then I give and bequeath the said slaves with their
 issue and increase to William, Henry, and Mary, children
 of my uncle George Thompson to them their heirs executors
 or administrators to be equally divided among them share
 and share alike, And Lastly I nominate and appoint Mrs Jane
 Thompson my Grand Mother above refered to, Executrix and
 my uncle George Thompson Executor of this my last Will and
 testament-----Witnefs my hand and Seal this Sixth day of
 February anno Domini one thousand Eight hundred and twenty
 five ----- George Thompson Jun (LS)
