No. 1 In the name of God Amen. I Godfrey C. Schutt  
being now of sound mind memory and understanding  
and being about 44 undertaking a Voyage to Havannah do  
make this my Last Will and Testament, first I desire that  
all my debts be paid. 2ly I will & bequeath unto my Wife  
Mary Ward Schutt all my right & Interest to the planta-  
tion Situated in St Pauls Parish called and Known by the  
Name of Wincoes also all my right to the negroes on the  
Said place which right is one half; the Said plantation  
and negroes being purchased and owned equally between my  
Brother John G Schutt and myself, the said plantation and  
negroes not to be Sold or bartered but with consent of my  
Brother John G Schutt who will have entire management of  
the aforementioned place. 3ly I will and bequeath to my  
Wife Marv W. Schutt all my right to the house and Lot  
Situated corner of Meeting and Fort Streets which right  
is one third, the said house being Owned by my Sister  
Harriett M Schutt my Brother John G Schutt and myself, the  
abovementioned House & Lot not to be sold but with con-  
sent of my Sister H M Schutt and my Brother John G Schutt  
4th my wife being now in a State of pregnancy, should it  
please the Almighty to bring my offspring to maturity or  
into the world, I desire that the aforementioned property  
and Whatever monies I may be worth, should be equally di-  
vided between my Wife and child and to be under the re-  
strictions mentioned in third and Second clauses. 5th  
Should my Wife marry she will forfeit all right to the  
property heretofore mentioned which right shall be claimed  
and given unto the child in which case the child shall be  
under the Guardianship of my brother John G Schutt. 6th  
I bequeath to my Wife whatever monies I am worth. 7th At

the death of my Wife and child I desire that the aforementioned property or if it be sold, the proceeds, be equally divided between my Sister Harriet M Schutt and my brother John G Schutt. 8th/Lastly I nominate and appoint my brother John G Schutt to be Executor to this my last Will & Testament. Charleston S.C. May 15, One thousand Eight hundred and twenty Six. Signed & acknowledged in the presence of

Codicils: On Second Consideration I will & bequeath unto my Sister Harriet M Schutt and John G Schutt all my right & Title to the House and Lot Situated in Meeting Street at corner of Fort Street which property is mentioned in the Clauses No 3, 4 and 5. Charleston May 15th 1826
