HANNAH PINCKNEY

17 1st In the Name of God Amen, I Hannah Pinckney some-
No 22 times called Hannah Mazyck of the city of Charles-
ton in the State of South Carolina being of Sound and dis-
posing mind and memory but weak in body and calling to
mind the uncertainty of Life and being desirous to dis-
pose of all such worldly Estate as it hath pleased God to
blefs me with do make and ordain this my Last Will and
testament in manner and form following that is to Say I
desire and direct that my Executors hereinafter named im-
mediately after my decease shall and do sell either at
public auction or private sale whichever in their discre-
tion they may think proper at the best price which can be
obtained for cash all that certain house & Lot situate in
Queen Street in the City of Charleston of which I am now
Seized and pofsefsed being Known as No 125 & measuring
thirty feet in front on said Queen street and one hundred
and thirty feet deep, and out of the monies therefrom a-
rising first to pay all my just Debts and funeral expences
and after the payment of all my just debts & funeral expen-
ces, to apportion distribute and pay the balance of the
monies in their hands arising from the Said Sale in the
following manner that is to say to my niece Sophia Living-
ston one hundred Dollars, to Elizabeth Anderson and Han-
nah Livingston Daughters of the said Sophia Livingston
one hundred Dollars each, to Thomas Cooper the son of W^m
Cooper who married my niece one hundred Dollars, to Han-
nah McKenzie Mishaw and Richard Mazyck Mishaw One hundred
Dollars each and the balance remaining in the hands of my
Executors after payment of the above Legacies, to be paid
over by my said Executors to my Niece Hannah McKenzie.
Item it is my further will & desire that in case the said
Hannah McKenzie should die before the sale of the said

property and the disposition of the monies therefrom arising as abovementioned that then the balance remaining in the hands of my Executors after payment of my just debts and funeral expences and the Legacies above named to Sophia Livingston Elizabeth Anderson and Hannah Livingston Thomas Cooper Hannah McKensie Mishaw and Richard Hazyck Mishaw abovementioned shall be paid over to John Spencer Mann Mishaw. Robert McKensie Mishaw Hannah McKensie Mishaw and Richard Hazyck Mishaw the Children of John Mishaw or the Survivors of them share and share alike. Item I hereby give devise and bequeath unto Hannah Livingston the daughter of my said niece Sophia Livingston all my Cloathing beds and bedding and all my chamber furniture to her and her assigns forever. And Lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my friends John Mishaw and Jehu Jones Executors of this my Last Will and testament hereby revoking all former Wills by me made In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and Seal this fourth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred & twenty Six and in the fiftieth year of the Independence of the United States of America.
