In the Name of God Amen, I Hannah Pinckney sometimes called Hannah Mazyok of the city of Charleston in the State of South Carolina being of Sound and disposins mind and memory but weak in body and calling to mind the uncertainty of Life and being desirous to dispose of all such worldly Estate as it hath pleased God to plefs me with do make and ordain this my Last Will and testament in manner and form following that is to Say I desire and direct that my Executors hereinafter named immediately after my decease shall and do sell either at public auction or private sale whichever in their discretion they may think proper at the best price which can be obtained for cash all that certain house & Lot situate in queen Street in the City of Charleston of which I am now Seized and pofsefsed being Known as No 125 & measuring thirty feet in front on said Queen street and one hundred and thirty feet deep, and out of the monies therefrom arising first to pay all my just Debts and funeral expences and after the payment of all my just debts & funeral expences, to apportion distribute and pay the balance of the monies in their hands arising from the Said Sale in the following manner that is to say to my niece Sophia Livingston one hundred Dollars, to Elizabeth Anderson and Hannah Livingston Daughters of the said Sophia Livingston one hundred Dollars each, to Thomas Cooper the son of w Cooper who married my niece one hundred Dollars, to Hannah McKenzie Mishaw and Richard Mazyck Mishaw One hundred Dollars each and the balance remaining in the hands of my executors after payment of the above Legacies, to be paid over by my said Executors to my Niece Hannah McKenzie. Ttem it is my further will & desire that in case the said Hannah McKenzie should die before the sale of the said

property and the disposition of the monios therefrom abising as approximationed that then the palance comming in the bands of my Executors after payment of my just Napte and Lancial expenses and the federies appear named to Sophia Livingston Elizabeth Anderson and Mannah Livingston Phomas Cooper Mannah McKenzie Michay and Sichard Manyok Mishaw abovementioned shall be paid over to John Spencer Mann Miehaw. Nobert McKenzie Miehaw Manman McKensie Eishaw and Nichard Magrok Eishaw the Children of John Michae or the Survivors of them share and share alike. Item I hereby give device and bequeath unto Mannah Livingston the daughter of my said niece Scphia Livingston all my Cloathing beds and bedding and all my chamber furniture to her and her afsigns forever. and Lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my friends John Mishaw and Jehu Jones Erecutors of this my Last will and testament hereby revoking all former Wills by ne made In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my gand and Seal this fourth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred & twenty Six and in the fiftieth year of the Independence of the United States of America.
