 N 27 Elnathan Haskell of Charleston South Carolina considering
 ing the uncertainty of this mortal Life and being of sound
 mind and memory (blessed be almighty God for the same) do
 make & publish this my Last Will and Testament in the manner
 and form following that is to say First, I give and bequeath
 unto my beloved Wife Charlotta Haskell all my Estate both
 real and personal for and during her natural Life so long as
 she remains unmarried, at her death or marriage all the prop-
 erty both real and personal except what the Law may allow her
 shall be equally divided between my following named Children
 unless my dear Wife may sooner choose to make such division
 of said property between them Vis Charlotta the wife of James
 H Smith, Charles, William, Pauline Eugenia & Emma. It is how-
 ever my Will that all my just debts be paid before a division
 of the property is made. My Daughter Julia the wife of States
 Rutledge being already provided for no provision is intended
 by this will to be made for her--On a final division of the
 property my Daughter Charlotte is Chargeable with three ne-
 groes vis ^b Elisa her son Robert and Edward the son of Mariah
 as and being a part of her proportion which she has been for
 some time in possession of, to Haskell Smith I give my Gold
 Watch and chain. Thereby appoint my Well beloved Wife my
 Executrix and my Sons Charles and William Haskell and my son
 in Law James H Smith my Executors of this my Last Will & tes-
 tament ----- E Haskell (LS)
