The State of South Carolina. In the Name of God Amen. I Henry
Averell of the City of Charleston, in the State of South Carolina appear
on this second day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
hundred and nineteen do make and publish this my last Will and
Testament in manner and form following, that is to say, I will
and direct that all my just debts and funeral expenses, be paid
and satisfied by my Executors hereinafter named, as soon as
can conveniently be done after my decease. Then I will and direct
should there be the Sum of Five thousand Dollars or more of my
property remaining, that my ^{said} Executors lay it out in Stock, or
place ^{it} at Interest, as they may think best or most expedient, in
that they pay over the income arising therefrom half yearly to my
beloved wife Louisa Catharine Averell, for the support of herself
and of my two Daughters Louisa Catharine and Helen Griffith,
until the youngest of my said daughters, or the Survivor of them shall
arrive to the age of eighteen years: but should my said wife have
married again, when the youngest of my said daughters, or the Survivor

of them shall arrive to the age of eighteen years, then, I will and direct my
my property so invested in stock or placed out at interest as aforesaid, be
equally divided and paid over to my said daughters, share and share alike
~~and~~ in case of the death of either of them, then the whole to be paid over
to the Survivor of them: but in the event that my said daughters or
either of them shall not live to attain the age of eighteen years,
then, I will and direct my said property to be paid over to my
said wife: but in case there should ^{be left} of my property after paying
my just debts and funeral expenses a less sum than Five thou-
sand Dollars, then, and in that case, I will and direct the same
to be paid over to my said wife to and for her own use, and benefit ab-
solutely. And I do hereby constitute and appoint John Hunter
and Timothy Street Executors of this my last Will and Testament.
