and desire that all my just Debts be paid -
Secondly, I do give, and it is my most earnest Will
and desire and particular request, that my Executors
do give all my Slaves their immediate Freedom
Thirdly, I give and bequeath unto my old Negro
Woman Call'd Lucy Two hundred Dollars for her
maintenance and support. Fourthly, I give and
bequeath unto the Methodist Episcopal Church Society
in Charleston in the State aforesaid all my Real
Estate, Houses and Lands, to them and their Successors
forever; The Rents thereof, or the proceeds arising
from the Sale thereof to be by them appropriated to the
purpose of propagating the Gospel of Jesus Christ
in that manner and way as they shall judge most
conducive thereto. Fifthly, I give and bequeath to
my Executors the Balance of my Estate in Return
for their kindness which they shall do for me and
mine. Lastly, I constitute and appoint my worthy
friend Philip Whill John Anthony

from the said. I hereby give and bequeath to the
purpose of propagating the Gospel of Jesus Christ
in that manner and way as they shall judge most
conducive thereto. Fifthly I give and bequeath to
my Executors the Balance of my Estate in Return
for their kindness which they shall do for me and
mine. Lastly I constitute and appoint my worthy
Friends John O'Land, Robert Pelly, John Anthony
and George Ains Executors to this my last Will and
Testament: In Witness whereof I have set my hands
and seal this 9th. Day of July 1817
