Item it is my wish that all of my property both real and personal should be kept together by my Executrix and Executors provided there is as much made after defraying the expences of my family as will pay the Installments I owe and the interest thereon But should they not affect the same it is my will and desire that they should take such Steps as they in their wisdom deem proper to affect the same and as soon as it is accomplished it is my wish and desire that the whole of my Estate both real and personal should be divided into three equal parts vis the one third to my beloved wife Sarah R Rivers to her and her heirs forever and one third to my daughter Julianna Bee to her and the ifsue of her body forever and the other and the Last third to my Daughter Elizabeth Ester to her and the ifsue of her body forever. Item my Will is that if either of my Children die leaving no ifsue of their body the deceased ones part or portion should go to the Survivor to be held as her own part or portion. Item and in case both of them should die Leaving no ifsue of there body it is my will that there respective portions should be equally divided between my Sister Kezzia Ree's children. Lastly I nominate constitute and appoint my beloved Wife Sarah Ecklin my Executrix and my friends Charleston Co. Wills
