v. 26 of the City of Charleston in the State of South Carolina do make & publish
my Last Will and Testament in manner and form following that is to
say, I impinge my will and direct all my just debts and funeral expences
to be paid as soon as may be convenient after my death. Then after the
payment of my debts and funeral expences I give devise and bequeath
all my property and estate real and personal whatsoever I have possessed
unto my five dear children to be equally divided among them share
and share alike to them respectively, their heirs and apprises forever and
should any of my said children die before attaining the full age of twenty
one years without leaving lawfully begotten issue living at the time of
his her or their death then my will is that the share of such child or
children so dying, whether specifically given or otherwise accuring to him her
or them under this will shall go to the survivor or survivors and to the issue
of any of my said children who may have previously died share and share
alike as Tenants in Common the issue of any deceased child or children ta-
king together only the share to which the parent or parents of above would have
been entitled. Then I authorize and empower my Executors hereinafter
named or such others as qualify, and act on this Will and the survivor of
them to sell and dispose of at public or private sale for Cash or on credit
as may be thought most advantagous all or any part or parts of my
estate Real and Personal and good and sufficient for the expenses

unto my five dear children to be equally divided among them
and I have alike to them respectively, their heirs and assigns forever and
should any of my said children die before attaining the full age of twenty
one years, without leaving lawfully begotten issue living at the time of
his her or their death then my will is that the share of such child or
children so dying, whether specifically given or otherwise owing to him her
or them under this will shall go to the Survivor or Survivors and to the issue
of any of my said children who may have previously died I have and have
alike as Tenant in Common the issue of any deceased child or children ta-
king together only the share to which the parent or parents if alive would have
been entitled. Item I authorize and empower my Trustees hereinafter
named or such others as qualify and act on this Will and the Survivor of
them to sell and dispose of at public or private sale for Cash or on Credit
as may be thought most advantageous all or any part or parts of my
Estate Real and Personal and good and sufficient Title, answering
and assurances in the Law to make therefore and for every part thereof
and I constitute and appoint my said Trustees to Guardian of the
persons and Estate of my Minor Children, Item I constitute nominate and
appoint my Dear Daughters Sidney Greenhill Elizabeth Van Greenhill and
Jane Greenhill Executrixes of this my last Will and Testament freely
revising and amending all former Wills by me heretofore made and
ratifying and Confirming this and no other to be my Last will & Testament
