blessed be God for the same, but calling to mind the
mortality of my body and convinced that it is ap-
pointed for all persons once to die do make and
ordain this my last Will and Testament in form
and manner following. First I commend my
soul in the hands of God who gave it and my
body I commit to the earth to be decently inter-
red at the discretion of my Executors herein after
named, and as for such part of real and perso-
nal Estate which it has pleased God to bestow
on me, I give devise and bequeath the same
in the following manner. Imprimus I give and
bequeath to Susannah Elizabeth Larry the daugh-
ter of Robert and Cynthia Larry of the City of
Charleston and State aforesaid all that lot piece
or parcel of land which I lately purchased of
Robert Haig situate lying and being in the
City of Charleston aforesaid on the East side of
King Street a few doors to the northward of
Tradel Street and at present occupied by George
Sheed Esquire containing from north to south
on said street twenty feet more or less and in
depth from west to east two hundred and
thirty five feet more or less butting and bound-
ing to the west on King Street aforesaid to the
south on land now or late of Alexander Ross
to the east on land of Charles Warham and
to the north on land late the Estate of George
Ross but now of Samuel Warren together
with all and singular the houses out houses
buildings hereditaments rights members and
appurtenances whatsoever to the same be-
longing or in any wise appertaining to have
and to hold the said lot of land with all and
singular the premises and appurtenances and
the rents Issues and profits thereof unto the said

1. Susannah Elizabeth Larry and the heirs of her body lawfully begotten for ever and in case she should marry then notwithstanding her coverture to receive and take the rents Issues and profits thereof for her own sole and separate use and the heirs of her body without any controul or hindrance or interference of her husband and not to be any wise liable for his debts, contracts or engagements whatsoever, to the intent that the said house and lot and the premises before mentioned may be firmly settled on the said Susannah Elizabeth Larry and in case of marriage for the sole benefit of her and the heirs of her body for ever. But in case it should so happen that the said Susannah Elizabeth Larry should die before marriage or after marriage should die without lawful issue then and in such case I will and bequeath that the said house and lot and all and singular the premises before mentioned shall revert back to John and Peter Larry sons of the aforesaid Robert and Cynthia Larry and when the youngest (Peter Larry) shall arrive to the age of twenty one years the said house and lot and the premises before mentioned shall be sold by my Executors and the monies arising therefrom shall be divided between them. The said John and Peter Larry equally share and share alike. I also give and bequeath unto the said Susannah Elizabeth Larry my negro Wench named Lucy to have and to hold the said Wench Lucy together with her future issue and increase unto the said Susannah Elizabeth Larry and the heirs of her body for ever. Item I give and bequeath unto Peter Larry and John Larry aforesaid to be equally divided between them share and share alike.

that my lot of land in Stolls Alley in the City of
Charleston aforesaid which was purchased of Oliver
Hart and Sarah his Wife together with all and sin-
gular the buildings Hereditaments rights members
and appurtenances to the said lot in Stolls Alley
aforesaid belonging or in any wise appertaining
to be equally divided share and share alike as afore-
said between the said John Larry and Peter Larry
their heirs and assigns for ever. Item I give and
bequeath unto the aforesaid Cynthia Larry Wife
of the said Robert Larry the use and services of
all the residue of my slaves and their future issue
and increase which may belong to me at the time
of my decease, to have hold and enjoy all and sin-
gular only the services, profits, income and emolu-
ments of such negro or other slaves unto the said
Cynthia Larry for and during the term of her na-
tural life, and from and immediately after her
death I will and desire that the said Negro or other
slaves together with their Issue and Increase shall
revert to John Larry, Peter Larry and Susannah
Elizabeth Larry aforesaid (and in case of her
marriage for her separate use benefit and behoof)
to be equally divided between them share and
share alike, for the sole use benefit and behoof
of them the said John Larry, Peter Larry and
Susannah Elizabeth Larry or the survivors or
survivor of them his her or their heirs and as-
signs for ever. And all the rest and residue of
such personal and real Estate not herein already
bequeathed or which I may possess at the time
of my decease I will and desire that the same
shall be equally divided share and share alike
between the said Children Susannah Elizabeth
Larry, John Larry and Peter Larry for the sole
use benefit and behoof in manner aforesaid of them

or the survivors or survivor of them his her or
their assigns for ever. And lastly I do hereby ordain
nominate and appoint my friends Edward Pres-
cot, William Inglesby and Charles Snowden Ex-
ecutors of this my last Will and Testament and
I do hereby revoke and make null and void all for-
mer and other Wills by me at any time hereto-
fore made and do publish and declare this to
be and contain my only last Will and Testa-
ment. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set
my hand and seal this twenty eighth day of
May in the Year of our Lord one thousand se-
ven hundred and ninety five.
