ing. Item: I give & Bequeath to my Loving Mother Hester
Huggins, The one half of my Tract of Land which I now
live on, The half on which the dwelling house now stands
to her and her heirs and assigns forever. Item: I will
and bequeath to my aforesaid Mother Hester Huggins -
the six following slaves, named as follows - Andrew, John
Deemster, Nehemiah, Hester, and Charlotte, to her and her heirs
and assigns forever. Item I give & bequeath to my sister
Hester Lydia Huggins the remaining half of the land
aforesaid, that is I give and bequeath to my sister
Hester Lydia Huggins the one half of my Land in Christ
Church Parish the moiety that has no improvements on it.
Item: I give and Bequeath to my sister Hester Lydia Huggins
the four following married Negroes, Henry, Mary, Wagon
and Duke she to have and to hold the aforesaid Land
and Negroes the Bequeathed to her to her heirs and assigns

Huggins. The one half of my Tract of Land which I now
live on. The half on which the Dwelling House now stands
to her and her heirs and assigns forever. Item: I will
and bequeath to my aforesaid Mother Hester Huggins —
the six following slaves, named as follows — Andrew John
December, Nehiah, Hester, and Charlotte, to her and her heirs
and assigns forever. Item I give the bequeath to my sister
Hester Lydia Huggins the remaining half of the land
aforesaid, that is I give and bequeath to my sister

Item: I give and Bequeath to my sister Hester Lydia Huggins
the four following named Negroes, Harry, Mandy, Hagar
and Duke she to have and to hold the aforesaid Land
and Negroes thus Bequeathed to her, to her, and her
heirs and assigns forever. Item I give and Bequeath
to my Brother John G. Huggins my Saddle and Saddle
and Bridle together with all my cloths and Ten
Hollars. Item: I give and bequeath to my sister Jan
A. Simmons Ten Hollars. Item I give and Bequeath
to my Niece Ann Simmons and my nephew Dennis

Jacob Simmons Two dollars each, and lastly I do constitute and appoint my Mother Hester Huggins my executrix and my friends Captains James Whittin and Nicholas Manning with my executors to this my last Will and Testament and I do hereby revoke all and other Wills made by me before this, and I do hereby declare this to be my last Will & Testament, dated this Twenty fifth day of March in the Year of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and Nineteen.
