in the State of South Carolina, Planter, being weak and low
in body, but of sound and disposing mind memory and
discretion praised be God for the same, considering that it is
prudent and right that I should dispose of the realty
Estate wherewith it has pleased God to bless me do make this my
last Will and Testament in manner and form following, that
is to say, In the first place I give my body to the Earth from
whence it came to be decently buried under the direction of
my Executors. Item. I will and desire that all my legal debts

202. and funeral expenses to be paid as friendly as may be con-
sistent with the interest of my Estate under the direction
of my Executors. I now give and bequeath to my grand-
daughter Mary Eliza Schmidt daughter of Elizabeth Schmidt
House in King Street the next to the Store of M. Dowd
& Black and now in the occupation of M. Carwin also the
five following negroes Maria Charlotte, Marven, John
and Lucy to her, her heirs, Executors and administrators for-
ever, according to the nature of the Estate. This House and
these negroes are to be taken as her Share or proportion of my
Estate and must be valued to ascertain the proportion. The
rest and residue of my Estate real and personal in posses-
sion, remainder or reversion I give devise and bequeath
to be equally divided between my daughter Mrs Elizabeth
Schmidt and her children John F. Schmidt, Mary Eliza
Schmidt, Jacob Schmidt, Wilbrand Schmidt and
Henrietta Porter Schmidt Share and Share alike, the
said House and five negroes bequeathed to Mary Eliza
being considered and taken as part of her Share. The
Share of said Elizabeth Schmidt shall vest and become her
absolute Estate at my decease, but it is my Will that the
said Share of my daughter Elizabeth shall not be sub-
ject to her debts ^{or contracts} in any manner.

Share of said Elizabeth Schmidt shall vest and become her

It is further my Will that ^{for} the purpose of ascertaining the true
value of my Estate and the respective proportions of my daughter
and grandchildren, my Estate real and personal shall be sold
at such convenient time as my Executors shall appoint. The
County Property to be sold after the crop is got in, always excepting
the House and negroes devised to Mary Eliza which shall be fairly
valued and the amount deducted from her share. During the
minority of my said grandchildren the income of their respective
shares shall be applied to their maintenance and Education.
In regard to the land and buildings belonging to me which
are at present in the possession of Elizabeth Williman, it is my
Will that the said Elizabeth Williman be permitted by my Executors
hereinafter named to use and occupy the same during her life and
no longer upon this condition that the said Elizabeth shall within

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twelve months after my decease, I hereby release in writing of
her claim right title to said lands buildings and all other
parts and portions of my Estate except under this my last Will
