bequeath all my real and personal Estate of whatever nature and
wherever it may be unto my respected friends James O'Reilly,
James White and Alexander England of the City aforesaid,
Trustees, to them and to the Survivor of them in full and ab-
solute fee simple forever, In trust nevertheless and to and for
the following special trust and confidence, viz. that my said
trustees or the Survivor of them, his heirs executors or admi-
nistrators, shall have and hold the same for the use and
benefit and to apply the rents issues and profits thereof to
and for each of the children of my beloved brother Marmaduke
Jenny and of my deceased brother Washington Jenny, to each
of the said children now living and to the children of any of
the said children who may have died leaving issue lawfully begotten, and to
the Survivors or Survivor of them share and share alike; and I do
hereby nominate and appoint my friends before named, viz.
James O'Reilly, James White and Alexander England Executors
of this my last Will and Testament with ample power to them to
do all things needful to carry into effect the foregoing pro-
visions charging them with the payment out my said Estate
of all my just debts if any there should be. In witness whereof
