publish and declare this my last Will and Testament in manner

my invariable practice promptly to settle all demands on me. I will
and direct my Executors and Executors hereinafter named to allow and
pay no demands against my Estate which the Statute of Limitations
would have barred at my death. Item I give devise and bequeath
all my Estate real and personal whatsoever and wheresoever to my dear
Wife Katherine Macbeth and our Children to be equally divided among
them share and share alike. Item I give and bequeath the Custody tuition
and guardianship of the persons and Estates of such of my Children as
shall be under the age of twenty One Years at the time of my death for
and during their respective minorities unto my dear Wife Katherine
Macbeth and my Brother Alexander Macbeth. Lastly I do hereby con-
