N<sup>o</sup> 39. In the Name of God Amen. I John Coburn of St. Pauls parish Planter, being of sound mind and understanding do make this my last Will and Testament in manner here following. I'mprimis. My Will is that all my just and lawful Debts be paid by my Executors as soon as possible after my decease. Item. I give and bequeath to my beloved Father and mother Robert and Elizabeth Coburn living near Belfast Ireland One hundred Pounds ~~£~~. The Balance of my Estate both real and personal to be equally divided between my beloved wife and my eight Children Viz. Jane Matilda, Caroline Ann, John, Ann, Peter Kennedy Coburn, Elizabeth, Thomas Scott Coburn and Simon Magrath Coburn. It is my will that as soon as it can be conveniently done that my Executors do sell <sup>all</sup> and every part of my Estate both real and personal (except my negro Diver Plenty, his wife Bina and her Children who will be mentioned hereafter, and such furniture and Servants as maybe thought necessary for the use of the family) for one half Cash, the balance in one and two years with a mortgage of the property and such other security as they may think necessary. It is my desire that my Executors purchase out of the Proceeds of my Estate a House and lot in some healthy part of the City for the accomodation of my wife and Children and the Balance of the Proceeds invested in United States Bank Stock or such other Bank Stock as maybe approved of by my Executors (except the share be

belonging to my wife which she is to have the use and control of each of the  
 Heirs to have their share invested in their own names, and the interest  
 arising therefrom to be paid to my wife by my Executors for their  
 support and maintenance, But the principal to remain untouched  
 until they shall severally attain the age of Twenty one years: but should  
 any of them die without having any lawful Issue before the attaining  
 the age of Twenty one years, then their part is to revert back to the  
 general Estate and be equally divided between the Survivors. It is  
 my desire that my negro Driver <sup>Plenty</sup> shall serve my wife for two years  
 after my death and then he is to be made free and fifty Dollars  
 paid him by my Executors, that his Wife Bina and her Children are not  
 to be sold but to remain part of the general Estate until my youngest  
 Child is of age when they together with the Horse and Lot and such  
 negroes with their increases as have been retained for the use of  
 my family are to be sold and the proceeds equally divided  
 between the Surviving Heirs so that a final Settlement should
