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 To be the last will and testament of buried at the Direction
 Executors hereafter named & as touching the disposal
 all such Imperial Estate, as it hath pleased Almighty
 to bless me with, I give and dispose of in the following man-
 ner & from First my will is that all my Just Dues & Arrears
 Charge be paid. It is my will that my Estate be sold & the
 now then from doeing to be kept at Interest for my Daugh-
 ter, to be paid to her when she attains the age of twenty one
 years of age, or marry which shall first be given. First it is
 my will that if my Daughter Mary Greenland should die
 before she attains to the age of twenty one years of age then
 in that case, then my Estate shall be equally divided be-
 my Brothers William & John Leighton, to be enjoyed by them
 & their Heirs forever, Lastly I appoint & nominate, my
 then William Greenland & John Leighton Executors of this
 my last will and Testament & I do hereby do with all
 mine with by me made & this to be taken for my last will
 Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
 & Seal before the Subscribing Witnesses on this 25 Dec
