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before all my children and of full age and old enough to be bound as
an apprentice that it is my Will that a Sufficient should be reserved
for the purpose of maintaining and giving the said child or children
a plain Education until he or they should arrive at such age and the
rest to be equally divided among all my children and heirs of their body
Item 3^d as my property consists of two lots on the East Side of Maysick
Street with the buildings thereon and five slaves it is my Will that if
at the time of the division of my Estate the increase of my personal Estate
should be sufficient to give one slave to each of my children it shall
be done, if not that the Rents of my houses should be reserved until suffi-
cient to purchase more for that purpose Item 4th I nominate constitute
and appoint my friend Abel McKee Executor and my beloved Wife
executing of this my last Will and Testament: given under my hand
and Seal this nineteenth day of November in the Year of our Lord one
