I give and bequeath the whole of my Estate both real and personal to my beloved Wife Elizabeth Peak to her free use during her natural life then after the death of my said Wife Elizabeth Peak I then give and bequeath the whole of my Estate both real and personal to my loving Son Oliver D Peak to him his heirs and assigns forever the notwithstanding it is my wish and intent that provides my Son Oliver D Peak \$ 500 before he should arrive to the age of twenty one years and without any lawful begetting upon me that case give and bequeath that part of my Estate I now hold which came to me with my beloved Wife Elizabeth Peak by marriage to Charles Dutton replied to my said Wife Elizabeth Peak to him his heirs and assigns forever and all the remainder of my Estate both real and personal I request to be given as follows. to say after the death of my beloved Wife Elizabeth Peak and my son Oliver D Peak to be divided twenty one year of age and without lawful issue as above mentioned I then in that case give and bequeath one third part of that part of my Estate yet left with
