in Charleston, make and declare to all whom it may concern that the
following Will is made and signed in my own Hand Writing and
which I declare to be my Last Will. That I name as my Executor Peter
Duguin Pillot my Brother and friend and whom I charge to have me
intended in the usual manner to pay my debts and to permit to each
one the Legacies mentioned below as soon as possible. moreover to de-
-liver immediately to my dear friend Marie Rose Derae all the moveables
and utensils in our use which I acknowledge belong to her as she earned
them by her Labour. with the Exception of my Furniture and Body Linen also
three Negroes which she obtained of me named Melly Constantine and Sarah
also to our Brother Bonstour Pillot Five hundred Dollars and to our Brother
Anthony Casimir Pillot Five hundred other Dollars. This contains my last
Will in presence of God I have put my Signature this fifth day of Decem-
-ber 1819.

Also I add to the above Will and I desire my Executor to permit my
dear friend Marie Rose Derae to enjoy during her life time my

House which we occupy, that she shall pay the Taxes and expenses of the repairs which she shall think necessary such is my Last Will. In testimony of which I have signed and after her death shall return to my heirs and assigns. See Bill of Sale

Charleston S. C. June 21st 1821 In the Name of God Amen I Andrew Hasell as my Last Will and Testament hereby nominate to constitute and appoint my beloved Wife Hannah Hasell Executrix and John Ashe Sen Doctor Paul Weston and Robert Quash Executors of my own Estate & Doctor Paul Weston and Jacob B. Son Executors of my Brother's Estate. Signed in the presence of

W. H. Hancock John S. Ashe Richard Ashe Codicil. Charleston S. C. 25 September 1821. The only change which is made to the above Will is substituting the name of Jacob B. Son as Executor to my Brother's Estate instead of Daniel H. Webb as originally written having been done when I was very low and my memory bad not that for a moment do think my worthy friend Webb would not do every thing for the Estate but it was my original intention to have appointed my friend Son If I had not the power of nominating Executors to that Estate my friend Doctor Weston I hope will administer on the same my wish is as it regards my wife and children.
