my negro boy named Joseph, and my other personal Estate that I am
in possession of at my decease. Lastly I do hereby nominate and
appoint Jennis Vonholten my sole Executor in witness whereof
I the said John Willkes have hereunto set my hands and seal -
Revoking all former Wills.
