

th Carolina. **Knowall Men** by these Presents that I Nathaniel Johnson of the Province of South Carolina Kn^t for & in consideration of a Bond bearing even date with these Presents wherein I said Nathaniel Johnson am held & firmly bound unto William Rhett of the said Province of Carolina mar^t in the Perall Sum of five hundred Pound Curr^t Moneys of Carolina, conditioned for the Paym^t of two hundred and fifty five Pound like Curr^t Moneys on the Nineth day of May which shall be in the year one thousand seven hundred & one as by the said recited Obligation of condition doth more at large appear & for the better Satisfying of said Sum of two hundred Seventy five pounds to be paid as aforesaid I have Bargained, sold & delivered & by these Presents in due form of Law do Bargain, sell & deliver unto the said W^m Rhett twelve negro men named Senors, Harry, Sambo, Jack, Jupiter, Brasso, Dick, Thomas, Deague, Simon, Polly & Comerson, two of which said Negroes Dick & Thomas being Lawyers, to have & to hold the said Bargained Premises unto the said W^m Rhett his Executors Administrators & assigns to the only use & behoof of the said W^m Rhett his Executors Administrators & assigns for ever, All which I said Nathaniel Johnson for myself my Executors & Administrators of said Bargained Premises unto the said W^m Rhett his Executors Administrators & assigns against all Persons shall & will warrant & for ever defend by these Presents Provided & Covenanted that the said Nathaniel Johnson myself my Executors & Administrators

Do well & truly pay or cause to be paid unto y^e said w^m Rhett his Ex^{ce}nt
Administrator or assignee y^e said Sum of two hundred & seventy five pounds
in Moneys of Carolina on y^e said Ninth day of May which shall be in y^e
fourth one thousand & seven hundred & one according to y^e true
meaning of y^e above recited Obligations condition for Redemption of
said Bargained Premises, When this Prest Bill of Sale to be
void or else remain in full force & virtue In Witness whereof
