all my Right title and interest in and to a certain Farm near the town
of Chelsea in the State of Massachusetts also two negro fellow Ser-
vants and Lincolns to her her heirs and assigns forever also for
and during her life the Services of my Negro Girl Hetty. To
my loving Daughter Sarah Hunt I give and bequeath all my
Right Title and Interest in and to a certain house or houses & lot
or lots in Kingston in the Island of Jamaica also a certain parcel
or quantity of plate formerly belonging to her mother deceased also
the negroes old Rose Patsy Mary Hamitt and Fanny together
with their issue and increase to her her heirs and assigns forever
and likewise the remainder of my title and interest in and to the
said Girl Hetty and her increase after the death of my said Wife

survive my said Daughter and her future issue then and in that

and desire that all my right title and interest in and to certain lots on
beard together with the houses and improvements where I now live shall
be and remain the joint property share and share alike to my said

live and should my Daughter or her future issue survive my Wife the
whole shall be vested in my said daughter Sarah her heirs and assigns
forever but should my Wife survive my Daughter and her future issue
then the whole of the houses and beared lots last mentioned shall

and assigns forever. It is my Will that all other species of property
Debts dues and demands of which I am legally possessed or entitled
to either here or elsewhere besides the property above specified shall

on the profits or income or wages of the negroes and house rent so long
as they both remain single and can make it mutually agreeable
to do so. And I do hereby nominate and appoint my friend

disannulling all former Wills by me heretofore made. Given under
