Amen I Josiah Phynney of the City of Charlesten  
State of South Carolina, Pilot and Mariner, being in good  
health of body and of sound disposing mind memory and un-  
derstanding, praise be unto God for the same, being also  
mindful of the uncertainty of this Life, and that great  
change when it shall please God to call me hence do make  
this my Last Will and Testament, First and principally I  
commend my Soul into the hands of Almighty God my Creator  
who gave it hoping for free pardon & remission of Sins  
and to enjoy everlasting happiness in his heavenly King-  
dom through Jesus Christ my Saviour. Secondly my body I  
commit to the earth to be interred at the discretion of my  
executors hereafter named and as to such worldly estate  
wherewith it hath or may hereafters/please God to intrust me  
I dispose of the same as followeth that is to say all my  
just debts and funeral expences as soon after my decease  
as conveniently may be I wish paid and after payment there-  
of my Will and desire is that my beloved Wife Eliza Phyn-  
ney should have and enjoy the whole of the incum arising  
from my Estate whethersoever being, both real and personal  
during her Wodowhood for the Support of herself and Chil-  
dren Juliana James Susan and Eliza Heneretta, but should  
she wish to dispose of my Said Estate real or personal  
during her said widowhood I hereby Will and give full and  
absolute power so to do, and in the event of my said Wife  
intermarrying my said estate shall still continue under  
her Controle & Subject to disposal of any part or the  
whole of my said Estate real and personal for the advan-  
tage and encrease thereof under the judgment of my hereaf-  
ter named Executors and to will and dispose of the said Es-  
tate in Such manner and form she may deem proper amongst

my children share and share alike or as her discretion may dictate, and I do hereby nominate Constitute and appoint my esteemed friends James May and Morgan Scott both of the City of Charleston State aforesaid to be Executors of this my Last Will and Testament hereby revoking and making null and void all former or other Wills and Testaments by me heretofore made. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal the nineteenth day of August in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty three.
