In the Name of God, Amen. I Joseph Wiggall, of the
Parish of Christ Church, in the State aforesaid, Planter, do make
this my last Will and Testament, in manner and form following: I
give to my Wife Sarah Wiggall the sum of five shillings sterling
in addition to the settlement I made on my said Wife before marriage
and which I declare to be intended by me in lieu of all dower and dower
which she can or may have in or to my Estate. Item I give to my daughter
M^{rs} Catharine Durand Wiggall, for ever, my two Negroes
named Bella and Peggy, with their Issue and Increase to be born
after the date of this my Will. Item I do hereby manumit and for
ever set free from the Bond of slavery my house Wench Senah
and little Senah, (the daughter of my Wench Pinah) with her Issue
and on the day on which my Son Levi shall attain the Age of twenty
years, (at which day I desire him to be considered as of age,) I also
manumit and for ever set free the said Wench Pinah and her daughter
Mary, and I require of my Executors to permit them to reside on my
Plantation. And in case my Son Levi should die under the said Age of
twenty years, then I manumit the said Wench Pinah and her daughter
Mary from the day of his death. Item I do hereby also manumit

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ever set free my Mulatto Boy Prob. I now give full authority to my Executors to sell and dispose of such part of my real Estate they may deem requisite for the payment of all my just and lawful debts. I now give, devise and bequeath to my Son Levi, his heirs and assigns for ever, all the rest and residue of my Estate, both real and personal whatsoever and wheresoever, and it is my desire that full possession thereof may be given him on his arrival at the Age of twenty years. But in case my said Son Levi should die before his arrival to the Age of twenty years I give and bequeath all the Estate and Property herein and hereby given to or intended for him, unto my daughter Catharine Durand Wigfall and her heirs and assigns for ever. Lastly I nominate, constitute and appoint Robert Quash and Thomas Wigfall Esquires and my said son Levi Executors of this my last Will and Testament, requesting of them to take upon themselves the Execution thereof, And I do hereby revoke all former Wills by me made. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and Seal the twelfth day of January in the Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety seven.
