in my marriage Settlement but if she should depart this
life before attaining the age of eighteen years or day of
marriage I give and bequeath the Slave Edmund to my
husband George Fryer absolutely and the Slave Cooper
to my mother Margaret Furrer absolutely Item I give
and bequeath all the rest and residue of my property of
every kind and nature whatsoever without any exception
to my beloved daughter Julia Francis absolutely. Lastly
I nominate and appoint my husband George Fryer Executor
of this my last will and Testament Witness my hand
and seal this fifteenth day of July in the year of our
Lord one thousand Eight hundred & forty two
