South Carolina City of Charleston In the Name of God Amen, I
Syon Moses of the City of Charleston being now afflicted with a disease
which I fear will prove my last, but of sound mind, memory and
understanding do hereby make my last Will and Testament in manner
and form following that is to say, I hereby give and bequeath to my Daugh-
ter Hester or Betty Moss, a certain two story wooden dwelling house
situated in Swintons Lane in the said City purchased by me from
Henry Deayton the 1st of last December containing four Rooms together
with a Kitchen and Outbuildings near the same together with all
my right title and interest in or to the Lot on which said House
and buildings stand, to have and to hold to her her heirs Executors
Administrators and assigns forever. I give and devise to my said
Daughter Betty Moss in like manner One fourth of a Lot of Land
belonging to me situated in the Village of Remney on Charleston
neck. Further I direct my Executors and Executors hereinafter named
to pay to my said Daughter Betty Moss the Sum of One hundred
and fifty Dollars per Year in each and every Year either to be paid
monthly Weekly or quarterly the same to be collected out of the

Rents and profits of my Estate. I then I hereby give and devise the remaining
parts of my Lot in Romney to be divided Share and Share alike between my
Wife Abigail Moses and my two Sons Daniel Moses and Moses D. Moses
their heirs and assigns forever. All the rest residue and remainder of my
property I give to be divided Equally between my said Wife and my two
Sons. Subject however to the payment of the annual Sum of one hundred
and fifty Dollars as before mentioned to be paid to my Daughter Betty Moses
for whom it has been my chief intention in this my last Will and Testament
to provide a decent maintenance. And lastly I hereby nominate constitute
and appoint my said Wife and two Sons Executors and Administrators of this my
last Will and Testament hereby revoking all former Wills by me made here
Witness Whereof I have hereunto Set my hand and Seal at Charleston
this Sixth day of April in the year of the Christian Era one thousand
eight hundred and twenty one.
