 assigns forever and should either of my said Grand Sons die
 under age, or unmarried then the Slaves above devised to them to go to
 the Survivors or Survivor of them and their or his Executors Adminis-
 trators and assigns forever And should all my said Grand Sons
 so die then the said Slaves to go to my son William Sinkler and
 to his heirs forever. Item I give devise and bequeath unto my Grand-

give devise and bequeath unto my Grand daughter Elizabeth S
Thomson the following Negro Slaves to Wit my maid Nanny Leah
Jenny Clara and Isaac together with the future issue of such as
are females to have and to hold the said Slaves unto the said Eli-
zabeth S Thomson her Executors Administrators and assigns forever
and should either of my said Grand daughters die under age and
unmarried the negroes above devised to them to go to the Survivor
of them and should they both so die then to go to their Mother
Margaret A Thomson and should she be then dead to go to my
Son William Linkler and his heirs forever. Item I give devise &
bequeath unto my Executors herein after named and to their Executors
and administrators the sum of five thousand Dollars in trust
however to put said sum at Interest (by the purchase of Stock
or otherwise) and to apply the interest thereof towards the Education

the use during her life) to be equally divided between my son William
Sinkler and my daughter Margaret A Thomson after the death of the
said Elizabeth Sinkler the share of my daughter Margaret A Thomson
in said Slaves to be held however by my Executors in trust to pay

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and the profits of the labour of him of said Slaves unto my said Margaret during her life free from the Debt or Controld of her husband and at her death her portion of the said Slaves to be equally divided among her Children the issue of any deceased Child to take a Share equal to that of their Parent. and should the said Margaret die without issue living at her death then her portion of said Slaves to go to my Son William Sinkler free from any further Debt to him and his heirs forever Item touching all the rest residue and remainder of my Estate real and personal his profession, reversion and remainder I give devise and bequeath the same unto my Son William Sinkler his heirs Executors Administrators & assigns forever Lastly I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint my Son William Sinkler and my friend Samuel Dubon Executors of this my last Will and Testament.
