 at the discretion of my Executor hereinafter named and as
 for that worldly Estate it has pleased to blefs me with I
 give and dispose thereof as followeth. I will that all my
 just debts and funeral expences be fully paid and Satisfied
 I give devise and bequeath unto my nephew Henry Bremar my
 Lot of Land with the Buildings thereon situate in Alexander
 Street Mazyckborough to him and his heirs forever. I give
 and bequeath to my Nephew Henry Bremar my Mulatto slave
 named Hannah and her four Children named George Maria, Ann
 & Elizabeth to him and his heirs forever also my Celeret,
 the picture of an evening scene, my gold watch, a cotton
 counterpane, my bed room carpet, one Large table cloth, a
 mourning breast pin set with his family's hair, Mr William
 Austins Portrait in water Colours, 2 pictures of scenes in
 Holland & of a naval engagement, I give and bequeath to Mrs
 Louisa Burn in trust for her Daughter Maria Austin Burn my
 Negro girl named Mary to her & her heirs forever, also my
 bed bedstead mattrafs 2 pillows and a bolster 1 set of Bed
 curtains 4 window Curtians 1 Drefsing glafs 1 Wash handstand
 4 Pictures of Public Buildings in Philadelphia, 2 pr plated
 candlesticks 1 pr card Tables 1 Tea Table 1 Large arm Chair
 1 dozen Straw bottommed chairs my front room carpet, 1 pr
 fire dogs shovel and tongs 3 Waiters 1 chest of Drawers 6 Wind-

I give to my Mulatto Servant Hannah the rest of Cloaths and furniture in the back room and Kitchen I give to my Servant Maria a Woollen Mattrafs, pillow & bolster & a calico patch quilt. And I do nominate constitute and appoint my Nephew Henry Bremar sole executor to this my last will and testament hereby revoking and making Void all and every other Will and Wills any time heretofore by me made and do declare this to be my Last Will and Testament. In Witnefs whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this twenty sixth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and twenty six and the fiftieth of American Independance.
