The last will and Testament of Mary Anne Palmer of
the ^{state} of South Carolina of St. Stephens Parish Widow

It is my wish, that all my just and legal Debts shall be
paid as soon after my Decease as may be practicable.

I give and bequeath unto my Sons, Robert Marion Palmer, John
Palmer, Samuel Warren Palmer, and James E. Sumner Palmer
all that part, or portion of Lands, which I have become entitled
to, by the Death of my Husband, John Palmer, late of the
 Parish, and State aforesaid to be equally divided between them
share and share alike; but in case of the Death of one, or
either of my above named Sons, before they may attain the
age of Twenty one Years, or Marriage, I will that, his, or their
part, be equally divided share and share alike, between the
Survivor, or Survivors, to them and their Heirs forever -

I give bequeath unto my Sons Robert Marion Palmer, John Pal-
mer, Samuel Warren Palmer, and James E. S. Palmer my
part or portion of Cattle, under the same condition, and
provision as above mentioned respecting the Lands -

I give bequeath unto my Daughters, Rebecca S. Crutcher
Sarah M. Palmer, Herriot S. Palmer, and unto my Sons
Robert Marion Palmer, John Palmer, Samuel Warren Palmer,
and James E. S. Palmer, all the Negroes, I am entitled to
by the Death of my Husband - In case of the Death of

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age of twenty one years, or Marriage, I will that, her, or then
part, be equally divided and share alike, between the
Daughters, or Generators to them and their Heirs forever -

I give the Negroes unto my Sons Robert Marion Palmer, John Pal-
mer, Samuel Warren Palmer, and James E. J. Palmer my
part or portion of battle, under the same condition, and
provisions as above mentioned respecting the Lands -

I give the Negroes unto my Daughters, Rebecca J. Bruntunin
Sarah M. Palmer, Henriot J. Palmer, and unto my Sons
Robert Marion Palmer, John Palmer, Samuel Warren Palmer,
and James E. J. Palmer, all the Negroes, I am entitled to
by the Death of my Husband - In case of the Death of
either of my Daughters, bearing no Issue, but leaving
Husband or Husbands, It is my wish, that then, or their
Husbands shall be fully entitled to the portion, which
she, or they may have been entitled to; But in no case shall
the Husbands, be entitled to any share in case of the Death
of any of my other Children, after the Decease of my Daughter
or Daughters, Should any of my Children, who may be living
at my Death afterwards, die, before they attain the age
of Twenty one years, or before marriage, (except with regard
to my Daughters as above provided) in that case the share
of my Estate which such Child would have been entitled

to shall be divided among my surviving children and among
the issue of such as may be dead, in place of their
Parents respectively to share and share alike. I hereby nomi-
nate constitute, and appoint Joseph Palmer, James
C. Siman, John S. Boutwell, Stephen Sincay, and Thomas
Palmer, Executors to the my last Will and Testament. In
witness whereof, I have hereunto set my hands and Seal
this Twenty seventh Day of December, in the year of
our Lord, One thousand eight Hundred and Ninety
