of amount Sales it is my Will that my Executor dispose of the same in charity in
assisting any poor people who may deserve help in time of need. Item with regard
to the Lot which I hold in King Street as tenant of Mr. Marks Lazarus and for
which I pay him a grounds rent of Eighteen Dollars per by the quarter it is my
Will that the people who now live there be allowed to continue at the same
rents and it is my Will that the grounds rent and Taxes be first paid & whatever
remains that my Sister Fanny have the benefit and use of the same during
her life and after her death that Charles have in like manner the benefit
and use of it during his life and after his death that the same be given up
but it is my Will that the ground rent and Taxes being paid the Tenants be
not disturbed or dealt hardly with for the residue. Item as my Sister's husband
is a slave it is my Will that before the balance of the proceeds of the Lot in
Church Street be laid out in charity it be applied in preference to procure the
freedom of her said husband if he be living at that time. Item I give
out of the residue just above named to William Eden Fifty Dollars, on
further consideration I do bequeath out of the above residue before it is
applied either for purchasing my Sister's husband or in charity, the
sum of Fifty Dollars more to John Martin Logan. Fifty Dollars

348 now to his son John W. Warrington. And one hundred Dollars now to William Eden and Joseph Deas in trust as friends and also for the money now to William Eden. Lastly I do nominate and appoint Thomas J. Guinther Executor of this my Will.
