In the Name of God Amen. I Mary Brailsford of Charleston, Widow
do make and declare this to be my last Will and Testament. First
I direct all my just debts to be paid. Item I give and bequeath to my
Daughter Anna Bailey wife of Henry Bailey for her life my negro Woman
Becky and her two children free from the 6 annuities or debts of her present or
any future husbands and from and immediately after her death I give & bequeath
the said negro's with their future issue unto Henry Bailey her husband in trust

for his children and his Brothers and Sisters according to the limitations
 hereinafter particularly declared concerning the death of my Estate hereinafter
 after bequeathed in trust for him and his children. Item I give & bequeath
 unto Charles Kershaw his heirs Executors and assigns forever all & singular
 the rest residue and Remainder of my Estate both real and personal
 in trust for the following purposes, namely in trust that he the Said
 Charles Kershaw shall in order to effect a division sell and dispose of
 all and singular my houses lands and Negroes upon such terms as he
 in his discretion may require as most beneficial to my Legates, & Execute
 title for the same and receive the proceeds thereof. I then direct him to
 add to the sum of the net proceeds the following sums viz^d three hundred
 Dollars which is the Valuation I have placed on a Negro I gave my Son Mor-
 ton twelve hundred dollars which is the Valuation I have placed on a fami-
 ly of Negroes I gave my Daughter Christiana Skrine Wife of James B
 Skrine One thousand dollars which is the Valuation I have placed on a
 family of Negroes I gave my Daughter Harriet Paine Wife of Joseph
 Paine and Six hundred Dollars which is the Valuation I have placed on
 the Negroes above bequeathed by me to my Daughter Anna Bailey. I then
 direct that the sum total be divided into Six equal parts which I give and
 bequeath as follows viz^d One of the said Sixth parts after deducting therefrom
 the sum of Six hundred dollars (as aforesaid bequeathed in Negroes to
 Anna) I direct the said Charles Kershaw to pay over unto Henry Bailey

the sum of six hundred dollars (as aforesaid bequeathed in Negroes to Anna) I direct the said Charles Rusham to pay over unto Henry Bailey the husband of Anna which together with the negroes above bequeathed to Anna are to be held by the said Henry Bailey in trust for his said Wife Anna for the term of her natural life, free from the Contingent or debts of her said husband, and from and immediately after the decease of the said Anna in trust for the absolute use and behoof of the children of the said Anna Shaw and Shaw alike, but should she leave no child or Grandchild living at her death then the same to be held in trust for the brother and sisters of the said Anna, and their children to be divided equally among them and subject to the same trusts and conditions as are hereinafter created for the bequests made for their use respectively. Item another of the aforesaid Sixth parts after deducting therefrom the sum of one thousand dollars which I gave in Negroes as aforesaid to Harriet I direct the said Charles Rusham to pay over unto Robert R. Gibbs to be held by him the said Robert in trust for my said Daughter Harriet Paine for her natural life free from the Debts or Contingent of her present or any future husband, the income thereof to be regularly paid to her and for which her receipt alone shall be a sufficient discharge, and from and immediately after the decease of the said Harriet the same to be held by the said Robert in trust for the absolute use and behoof of the children of the said Harriet Shaw and Shaw alike, but should she leave no

Child or grandchild living at her death then the same to be held in trust for the
brother and Sisters of the said Harriet and their children to be divided equally among
them Subject to the same trusts and conditions as are declared in their respective be-
-queaths in this my Will. Item another of the aforesaid Sixth parts after deducting
therefrom the sum of Twelve hundred dollars which I gave in negroes as aforesaid
to Christiana I direct the said Charles Kershaw to retain and hold in trust for
my said Daughter Christiana Skins for her natural life free from the debts
or contracts of her present or any future husband the income thereof to be regu-
-larly paid to her and for which her receipt alone shall be a sufficient discharge
and from and immediately after the decease of the said Christiana the same
to be held by the said Charles Kershaw in trust for the absolute use of her
-said Son and Son alike but should she leave no child or grandchild living
at her death then the same to be held in trust for the brother and Sisters of the
said Christiana and their children to be divided equally among them Subject to
the same trusts and conditions as are declared in their respective bequeaths in
this my Will. Item another of the aforesaid Sixth parts after deducting there-
-from three hundred dollars given in a negro as aforesaid to my Son
Morton I direct to be disposed of by the said Charles Kershaw as follows
Viz: One half thereof to be paid immediately to the said Morton Bailsford
and the other half to be held by the said Charles in trust for the said Morton
during his natural life free from his present or future creditors, the income
thereof as it arises to be regularly paid him and from and immediately after
the decease of the said Morton the same to be held by the said Charles for

during his natural life free from his present or future Creditors; the income thereof as it arises to be regularly paid him and from and immediately after the decease of the said Morton the same to be held by the said Charles for the absolute use of the Lawful Children of the said Morton Share and Share alike but should he leave no child or Grandchildren living at his death then in trust for the Brothers and Sisters of the said Morton and their children to be divided Equally among them Subject to the same trusts and Conditions as are declared in their respective Legacies in this my Will. Item another of the aforesaid Sixth parts I direct the said Charles Kershaw to retain in trust for my Son James Brailsford for his natural life free from his present or future Creditors the income thereof as it arises to be regularly paid him and from and immediately after the decease of the said James the same to be held by the said Charles Kershaw for the absolute use and behoof of the Lawful Children of the said James Share and Share alike but should he leave no child or Grandchildren living at his death then to the said Charles Kershaw in trust for the Brothers and Sisters of the said James and their Children to be divided Equally among them Subject to the same trusts and Conditions as are declared in their respective Legacies in this my Will. Item the remaining Sixth part I direct to be disposed of as follows by the said Charles Kershaw Viz^d One half thereof to be paid immediately to my Son William Brailsford and the other half to be held by the said Charles in trust for the said William during his natural life free from his present or future Creditors the income thereof as it arises to be regularly paid him and from immediately

after his decease the same to be held by the said Charles Kershaw in trust for the absolute use and behoof of the lawful children of the said William Brailsford then and then alive but should he leave no child or grandchild living at his death then in trust for the brother and sister of the said William and their children to be divided equally among them Subject to the same trusts and conditions as are declared in their respective legacies in this my Will. Lastly I do hereby nominate and appoint Charles Kershaw Executor to this my Will and should he decline serving as Executor and trustee or wish after having served for any time to withdraw from the trust. I do hereby constitute and appoint such person as he the said Charles Kershaw shall nominate in writing to the Ordinary as Executor and trustee under this my Will in lieu of himself. And I do authorize all & Singular the trustees under this my will to invest the proceeds committed to their care in the most secure and profitable manner so that the most certain and largest income may be derived therefrom to my children.
