 No-26. } doosecreek. In the name of God Amen I Mary Brown of  
 the District and Parish aforesaid being now of sound mind and  
 memory though weak and afflicted with disease and having in mind  
 the mortality of my body, Knowing that all mankind must die do  
 make ordain and appoint this my Last will and Testament in the  
 manner and form following Viz<sup>t</sup>. first it is my will and desire  
 that my Executor hereafter named do have my earthly remains  
 interred in decent and Christian burial and afterwards as Soon  
 as Convenient pay all my just debts. Item I bequeath to Eliza  
 Ann Huff, daughter of Daniel Huff one young Cow and Calf to  
 be chosen from my stock. Item I bequeath to Susana Bunch one  
 Cow and Calf the rest of my stock after my decease I bequeath to  
 Daniel Huff aforesaid together with my Household furniture. My  
 Land I bequeath to be equally divided between my grandson Will-  
 iam Brown and Mr William Vance. My money and debts that can be  
 collected I leave and bequeath in like manner to be equally  
 divided between my grandson William Brown and William Vance  
 aforesaid and I do hereby appoint Mr Daniel Huff and Doctor  
 John Willson as my Executors to act and perform all things  
 necessary to the due execution of this my Last Will and testa-  
 ment hereby revoking cancelling and utterly disannulling all  
 former Will or Wills heretofore made or mentioned verbally or  
 in any manner whatever. In Witnefs whereof I have hereunto set  
 my mark and Seal this twenty second day of January in the Year  
 of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and twenty seven.
