He & I lately lived in together with y^e said house & all other buildings on y^e
P. Town lott Also my half of a parcell of land near Bermudas Town containing
fifty acres or thereabouts w^{ch} I purchased with my son Capt Charles Cassin
To have & to hold y^e P. Town lotte buildings & premises thereto belonging y^e y^r &
parcell of land near Bermudas Town William Bayley his heirs & assigns forever. Item I
give grant demise & bequeath unto my so son William Bayley one other town lott
situate in Charles Town which formerly belonged to y^e Capt John Clapp & whereon Capt
Charles Cassin & I lived in together with y^e houses & buildings thereon To have & to
hold unto my son William Bayley during his natural life
After his death I give grant demise & bequeath the P. Town lotte & premises to my two daughters
Elizabeth & Mary Bayley their heirs & assigns forever to be divided
between them equally I give grant demise & bequeath unto my daughter
Elizabeth Bayley one other town lotte in Charles Town
situate in the middle of the town

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
