Item I give and Bequeath unto my son Edwin a certain
by name Hannu with her increase, to him & his heirs forever

I give & bequeath unto my Daughters Mary G. Jenkins
Eliza & Charlotte A. Chaplin all the rest of my Negroes
to be equally divided between them & their heirs forever.

all my part of the Stock of cattle & sheep to be
equally divided between them. I give and
bequeath to my daughter Mary S. Jenkins my Gold
Watch and all that belongs to it. I give &
bequeath to my Daughter Charlotte my work table.
I give and bequeath to my Daughter Eliza
and Son Edwin my set of Table China to be equally
divided between them. I give & bequeath to
my Daughters Eliza and Charlotte & Son Edwin
and Randall my thirds of the Furniture to be equal
divided between them. I give and bequeath
to my Husband Mr. Benjamin Reynolds all the
money of my part of the Cotton Crop —
