I give and bequeath to Mrs. Eliza Wilson daughter of William Hazell Gibbs Esq the Sum of one hundred pounds to Mr. Luke Holmes y Sum of two hundred Dollars, to Mr. Fabian sister of Ann Broughton One hundred dollars to Mr. Sophia Grimké my bedding and all my bed linen to Miss Caroline Marshall all my Cloathes and Ward robe to Miss Ann Marshall one hundred dollars and my Chest of drawers and Bedstead I give and bequeath my two houses one Corner of Meeting Street and Queen the other in Queen Street to be Equally divided between my Brothers Children I give my Merchants and Mechanics Bank Shares to my Nephew Frederick Grimké my South Carolina Bank Shares, Shares in the Union Insurance Company to be Equally divided, to be Equally divided between my Brothers Children Frederick Grimké to have an Equal Share in the two last mentioned Shares as well as y house, And I do appoint my friends Willm Hazell Gibbs Frederick Grimké and Thomas Grimké Executors to this my last Will & Testament hereby revoke all Wills made by me heretofore as Witness my hand and Seal this fourteenth day of November 1821. Physician being Sick and Weak of Body but of Sound & disposing mind memory and understanding Praised be God for the Same do make this my last Will and Testament. First and principally I commend my Soul to God my Almighty Creator who gave it hoping for full pardon and remission of Sins and to enjoy Everlasting Happiness in his Heavenly King dom through Jesus Christ my Saviour, my Body I Commit to the Earth to be interred at the discretion of my Executor, and as to Such Worldly Real and Personal Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to intrust me, I dispose of the Same as follows. I give and bequeath that is to say I wish that all my just Debts shall be paid in Charleston State of South Carolina and I do hereby appoint Josiah Parks my Executor to sell and dispose of all my personal property in the City of Charleston State aforesaid and to remit the proceeds of my Said personal Estate (after my just debts are paid in Charleston aforesaid) to my Executor & other Executor hereafter named to say I do hereby nominate and appoint my Wife Sarah Allen Executor and my Brother Samuel Allen (both of Washington Dutchess County State of New York) Executors of this my last Will
