Earth, at the direction of my Executor herein after named
 as to such Worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased

 I give devise and bequeath unto my two Children -

 equally divided among them Shares & Shares alike all
 the Property wherof I may be possessed of at the

 the age of Twenty One Years, or my said Son Marriage
 before attaining the age of twenty One Years, And in the
 event of either of my said Children dying before the age
 of Twenty One or day of marriage, I give devise and
 Bequeath the same I have given herein unto him or
 her unto the Survivors his or her heirs and assigns for
 ever, But in the event of the death of both of my
 said Children before the Day of their respective marriage
 or attaining the age of Twenty One Years, then my will
 And pleasure is that the said property / whatever the
 same may be, shall be equally divided between my
 two Sisters Anna W. Warner & Catharine F. Pomeroy

on attaining the age of Twenty One Years, then my will
and pleasure is that the said property / whatever the
same may be, shall be equally divided between my

their heirs and assigns for ever but in the event of
my said two Sisters leaving no issue at the time of
their deaths, my Will is that the said property should
become property of the Children of Robert Matthews of
Goose Creek I leave their heirs and assigns forever. I

Matthews Esquire of Goose Creek the sole executor of this
