 derstanding do make my Last Will and testament as follows.
 I give devise and bequeath the whole of my Property real
 and personal to my Sister Ann Leeseue and my Brother Pe-
 ter Leeseue to be equally enjoyed by them during their
 joint lives and from and after the death of either of them,
 then I give devise and bequeath the same to the survivor
 of them for and during the term of her or his natural
 life as the case may be and from and immediately after
 the death of such Survivor, then I give devise and be-
 queath the whole of my said property real and personal
 to my nephews & nieces equally to be divided amongst them
 share and share like to them their heirs executors ad-
 ministrators and assigns forever. And I do hereby nomi-
 nate and appoint my Said Brother and my friends Thomas
 Wigfall & Daniel Jennings Waring Executors of this my
 Last Will and testament hereby revoking all other and
 former wills by me at any time heretofore made. In Wit-
