I wish that my debts be paid and my wrongs redrefsed should any be found at my death. 4th I give and bequeath to the Chunch saint Finbar to contribute to the purchase of a Cemetery one hundred Dollars to be taken from the first funds which may be received from the indemnity granted by the French Government for my property which I have at St. Domingo. 5th I give and bequeath to Josephine a free mulattoe aged about ten years two hundred Dollars to be taken also from the funds coming from the said indemnity which said two hundred Dollars shall be placed out for her advantage but not to receive the Capital till she is twenty one years of age. 6th I name and constitute as my Executor Testamentary & Legatory general Mr Peter Bernard Boutan dispofsefsing myself in his favour at the

hour of up doubt of all my goods and rights whether Diteated at Churleston or St Domingo or elections for my said universal Legates to enjoy or dispose of in the sune manner as if my goods were always his property and in acproviedgment of the signal services which he done me by the particular cure he has taken of me during my sichness, whether in advances or otherwise, that I have received eron the said Gentleman since I have been in Charleston. T desire all those who have had any interest or affection for me to receive my last added and to parton the little groups which I may have committed towards them, declaring that by the present I forget all those of whom I have cause to complain and pardon them, done and Signed at murleston South Carolina this 39 February 1826, and 50 year of the Independence of the United States of America.
