Item I give to my grand Son peter Aaron Fulmer my negro boy Billy to him and his heirs forever. Item I give and bequeath to my Grand Daughter Mary Eliza Fulmer my negro girle Catterina with her future increase to her and her hears forever. Item I give and bequeath to my Grand daughter Ann Fulmer my negro girle Sarah with her future increase to her and her heirs forever Item I give and bequeath to my grand daughter Caroline Fulmer my negroe girle named Ria with her future increase to her and her her tone or. Willen I give and bequeath to my trand daughthy southe arolinapione arsneom boy named Joe to her and her heirs forever. Item I give and bequeath to my grand Daughter Rebecca w. Fulner my negro girle named girlia with her future increase to her and her heirs forever. Provided always that in case any of my grand children shall depart this life before they arrive at the age be intiled to her or his propertion to be equally divided share and share alike. Item I constitude and appoint my friends Charles King Lessone and william Patterson my Execuse to this my last will and testment revoking all otnessivate have hereunto set my hand and Seal the twenty ninth hundred and twenty five and in the forty ninth year of American Independence.
