17 R.⁵ State of South Carolina. This is the Last Will
 N^o 49 and Testament of me Mary Strother of the City of
 Charleston and State aforesaid Widow. I give and bequeath
 unto my two friends Mr Charles K Lesesne & Mr William Pat-
 terson all my personal estate whatsoever and Wheresoever
 upon the trust and to and for the uses intents and purpos-
 es hereinafter by me directed given and appointed that is
 to say. In trust neverthelefs that they the Said Charles
 K Lesesne and William Patterson and the Survivor of them
 his Executors and administrators do and shall pay thereout
 my just debts and funeral expences and the following lega-
 cies that is to say, I give and bequeath unto my daughter
 Ann Fulmer and to her heirs forever, not to be subject to
 the debts of her husband nor that he has no controul of
 the said property so bequeathed the following negroes Syl-
 via Sam Hagar Phoebe Doll Molly Bob and Tom with the in-
 crease of the females during her natural Life and at her
 death to be equally divided between her Surviving Children
 by her present husband but should should she wish at the
 marriage of any of her Children arrive at the age of twen-
 ty one to give any of the above named Negroes to either
 of them it is my Will and desire that my Executors have
 it done by a deed of gift. Item I give to my grand Son
 Peter Aaron Fulmer my negro boy Billy to him and his heirs
 forever. Item I give and bequeath to my Grand Daughter
 Mary Eliza Fulmer my negro girle Catterina with her future
 increase to her and her heirs forever. Item I give and
 bequeath to my Grand daughter Ann Fulmer my negro girle
 Sarah with her future increase to her and her heirs forever
 Item I give and bequeath to my grand daughter Caroline Ful-
 mer my negroe girle named Ria with her future increase to
 her and her heirs forever. Item I give and bequeath to my
 grand daughter Frances Maria Fulmer my negro boy named Joe

to her and her heirs forever. Item I give and bequeath to my grand Daughter Rebecca W. Fulmer my negro girl named Silvia with her future increase to her and her heirs forever. Provided always that in case any of my grand children shall depart this life before they arrive at the age of twenty one or Marry that the surviving grand children be intiled to her or his proportion to be equally divided share and share alike. Item I constitute and appoint my friends Charles King Lescane and William Patterson my Executors to this my last Will and testament revoking all others. In Witnefs whereof I the said Mary Strother the testatrix have hereunto set my hand and Seal the twenty ninth day of March in the year of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and twenty five and in the forty ninth year of American Independence.
