17 F² The State of South Carolina In the name of
N^o 5 God Amen I Mary Teasdale of the City of Charles-
ton in the said State widow being Sick and weak in body
but of sound and disposing mind memory and understanding
do make and declare this my Last Will and testament in man-
ner and form following that is to say. I direct that all
my just debts if any be paid by my Executor. I give and
bequeath to my daughters Mary Teasdale and Louisa Teasdale
equally to be divided between them the proceeds of the
sale of the five following named slaves & the future if-
sue and increase of the females of them Viz^t Grace and her
children Phoebe and Prince and Nora and her Child Bella
and should my said Daughters or either of them die unmar-
ried the shares of them or share of her so dying I give
and bequeath to be equally divided between my Daughters
Mrs McCants Mrs Wilkie & Mrs Mey their Executors Adminis-
trators or assigns I direct and request my Executor here-
inafter named to Sell and dispose of the said Slaves and
the future issue & increase of the females of them as soon
after my decease as can conveniently be done and to di-
vide the proceeds as I have bequeathed, and I further re-
quest my Executor to allow the said slaves a reasonable
time to seek the Owners or purchasers to whom they might
wish to belong. I give devise and bequeath unto my said
Daughters Mrs McCants Mrs Wilkie and Mrs Mey to be equally
divided between them their heirs and assigns forever all
my right title and interest of in and to all the lands
and other property real and personal in the State of New
York belonging to the Estate of my deceased uncle James
Vence. I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint my son
in law William Ball Wilkie Esquire of Charleston sole Ex-
ecutor of this my Last Will and testament. In Witnefs
