Do make publish and declare this to be my last Will and Testament of and concerning the worldly Estate it hath pleased God to bestow on me, after all and singular my just debts and funeral expences are fully paid and satisfied, I give devise and bequeath in manner and form following, that is to say, ~~vizt~~ I give and devise unto my Beloved wife Rachael Wells, the lot now live on, as at present divided off and enclosed by me, containing thirty feet front on Beaufain Street, and in depth ^{feet} together with the buildings and improvements thereon standing, to have and to hold to her, her heirs and or assigns forever. Also I give unto my said wife Rachael Wells my other lot of land adjoining the above & to the Eastward thereof, divided off and enclosed by me, together with the buildings, and improvements thereon now standing; But nevertheless in Trust to and for the special uses and purposes hereinafter mentioned, that is to say, the one half of the rents, issues and profits, as it may be received by my said wife to the use and behoof of my dear daughter Hester Wigfall to have and her heirs; and the other or remaining half of the said rents, issues and profits to the use and behoof of my said daughter Hester Wigfall to have and her heirs.
