N^o 2 aforesaid being of sound mind and memory Blessed
be the Almighty God for the same, do make & ordain
this my last will and Testament in manner & form fol-
lowing viz In the first place. Item. It is my will
and desire that all my just debts be paid & settled.
Item I give to my beloved wife Mary Cooper the use
occupation and enjoyment of my house and lots
number (62 & 64) Anson Street in Charleston aforesaid
and my household and kitchen furniture for and
during the term of her natural life. Item. Should my
wife Mary Cooper die before my daughter Caroline
Cooper then in that case I give devise and bequeath
unto the said Caroline Cooper the aforesaid lots (nos 62 & 64)
Anson Street with the household and kitchen furniture
to her & her use and bequeath. Item. Should my
daughter Caroline Cooper die before her mother Mary
Cooper leaving lawful issue then in that case it is my
will that a portion of my Estate shall go the most

Support of my wife Mary Cooper and said lawful issue,
(the issue of the deceased Caroline Cooper representing
the Parent) Item Should my daughter Caroline Cooper
die before her Mother Mary Cooper leaving no lawful
issue, then in that case it is my will that that portion which
would have gone to her issue shall go to my wife Mary
Cooper. Item Should my wife Mary Cooper and my
daughter Caroline Cooper die before me or after me
leaving no lawful issue then in that case it is my will
and desire that whatever property they would have enjoyed
under this my last will and Testament both real and
personal shall go to the female children of my three sisters
viz Mrs Susannah Brown Mrs Hannah Hunt and Mrs
Martha Jocelyn now or lately residing in the States
of Connecticut and Massachusetts to be equally divi-
ded among them share and share alike to them and
their heirs forever Item It is my will that the remain-
der and residue of my Estate both real & personal
be improved disposed of and kept together as may seem
proper by my Executors and Executors, and for the best
advantages The net annual income thereof I give and
bequeath unto my said wife Mary Cooper for and
during the term of her natural life and as her death is
my daughter Caroline Cooper to her heirs &c

And Lastly I do hereby nominate and appoint my
beloved Wife Mary Cooper Executrix William Swift
late of the City of Charleston aforesaid now residing
in New York William Bell and Thomas P.

this my last will and Testament hereby revoking all
former and other wills by me at any time heretofore
made In Witness whereof I have to this my last
will and Testament set my hand and seal this twenty
third day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand
Eight Hundred and forty six and in the seventeenth
year of American Independence
