ONERIME PELLOT

17 OF State of South Carolina. In the Name of God Amen
 N^o 46 I Onerime Pellet, a native of France a Citizen of
 the United States and resident in the City of Charleston in
 the State aforesaid being weak in bodily health but of sound
 and disposing mind and memory do make this my Last Solemn
 Will and testament hereby cancelling and revoking all and
 every prior Will or testament which I may heretofore have
 made. I commit into the hands of my Lord and Saviour Jesus
 Christ my immortal part, the Soul, my body to the earth
 from which it came, and where my friends will cause it to
 be decently interred. I desire that as soon as possible after
 my demise my funeral expences and Just debts be fully paid
 and discharged. I give and bequeath all the property I may
 have in France to my beloved Brother Antoine Casimir Pellet
 and in the event of my Surviving him I give and bequeath
 the same to his children to be shared amongst them in equal
 proportions and to their & each of their Executors, heirs
 administrators or assigns^s to be paid by my Executors here-
 inafter named. The rest and residue of my Estate both real
 and personal consisting of my property in this country (with
 the exception of my dwelling house on Meeting Street road
 hereinafter devised) I give and bequeath to my Executors
 hereinafter named and to the survivors of them upon the ex-
 perts understanding and trust that they hold the same and
 the rents wages and profits thereof subject to the sole use
 benefit and advantage of my good friend Catharine Artho, a
 Coloured woman that they do allow her absolute controul over^s
 the same and liberty to dispose in her Life time or by Will
 of the whole or any part thereof--With regard to my Dwell-
 ing house hereinbefore excepted, I bequeath the same to my
 Executors and the survivor of them in trust for the use bene-
 fit and behoof during her Life time of the said Catharine
 Artho--and from and after her death the said house and Lot
 in trust for her daughter Maria Clara, my adopted Child, to

her use benefit and behoof and that of her heirs Executors administrators and assigns forever. I hereby appoint as Executors to this my Last Will and testament my friends Francis Du Quercron and Francis Laborde and in Confirmation of the same I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this twenty third day of May in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred & twenty six at Charleston in the State aforesaid. Signed Sealed published and declared by Onerime Pillot as his Last Will and testament in the presence of us who at his request in his presence and in the presence of each other have herexxnte Subscribed our names-----
