she may hereafter have and also that my said Executors or Executor
do lay off from the most convenient part of my plantation whereon
I now live or of any of my Lands fifty acres of Land and that
my said Executors or Executor shall have built thereon a
decent comfortable wooden House, which said Fifty acres of Land
and House as aforesaid, I give to my said Negro woman Eloy
to her during her life and after her death to her said five chil-
dren named Beck, Harry, John, James and Nancy and to their
Heirs forever. Item. I also give to my said negro woman Eloy her
father by name Bristol and her mother by name Beck, and
also Five bows and balles and their increase to her during her life
and after death to her ^{said} five children named Beck, Harry, John
James and Nancy to them and their Heirs forever. I also give
to my said negro woman Eloy the sum of Fifty dollars which I
hereby direct to be paid her by my said Executors or Executor out
of my Estate immediately after my death. Item. I give devise
and bequeath unto my loving wife Abby and my loving daughter

herby direct to be paid her by my said ~~executor~~
of my Estate immediately after my death. Item. I give devise
and bequeath unto my loving wife Abby and my loving daugh-
ters Mary Martha and Caroline Charlotte Ravenel all the
rest surplus and residue of my Estate both real and personal

lastly I do constitute and appoint my loving wife Abby Ravenel
and my daughter Mary Martha Ravenel as Executrix and my
Brothers Henry Ravenel, René Ravenel, Stephen Ravenel, Daniel
James Ravenel and my Brother in law Mr. Francis Marion Jr.
as Executors of this my last Will and testament, hereby revoking all
