and in the same way, as the laws would have required it, had I
died intestate and further I do name & constitute my loving wife
Elizabeth my Executrix and my beloved Sons Arnaldus broft and
James Leman my Executors of this my last Will and Testament,
hereby utterly revoking and annulling all former Will or Wills
I may heretofore have made or executed, ratifying this and no other
to be my last Will and Testament. Signed sealed ^{and} and declared in
our presence by the testator, this Twenty third day of May one thousand
eight hundred and twenty and forty fourth of American Inde-
pendence.
