 also my Carriage and the Choice of any two of my Houses of which
 I may be possessed at the time of my decease. Item I give to my aforesaid
 Wife the use of my two Servants Chaner and Thomas as long as She
 remains my Widow and at her marriage or death I will my aforesaid
 Servants Chaner and Thomas to my Son Thomas Broughton
 to him and to his heirs and assigns forever. The residue of my Estate I
 Will to be sold. One fourth part of the proceeds of which I give devise and
 bequeath to my aforesaid Wife Mary Broughton to her to her heirs & assigns
 forever in lieu of Dower. the proceeds of the remaining three fourths I
 Will to be Invested in stock of this State or of the United States the Interest
 of which must go to the support and Education of my Children, and when
 my Son Thomas Broughton arrives at the age of Twenty One Years and
 my Daughter Susannah Broughton Broughton and Christiana
 Constantia Broughton arrive at the age of twenty one years or on the day
 of marriage I will that they each respectively receive an Equal Share
 of my Estate excepting always such part thereof as hath been already

and herein before devised to their children. And in case of the death of any of my
Children hereinbefore mentioned, before they may arrive at the age of Twenty one years
or many, then and in that case it is my Will that the Survivors or Survivor
the case may be respectively inherit the share or share of such as may so die, each
share and share alike. It is my Will also I enjoin it on my Executors & Executors
to give each of my Children a liberal Education and that my son Thomas Broughton
shall study some profession and if he will not make choice of one for himself
it is my Will that my Executor make choice of one for him. Should my Executors
be of opinion that it would be more advantageous to keep my Estate together
until my son Thomas arrive at the age of twenty one years it is my Will
that they shall do so and in that case it is my Will that my Widow shall have
a home on my Plantation called South Mulberry with privilege of planting

Mazysk and my son Thomas Broughton (when he arrive at the age of
